

- Rules and Conditions of Entry**
1. To be judged under NPS rules. These may be obtained from The National Pony Society Tel 01420 88333 or [www.nationalponysociety.org.uk](http://www.nationalponysociety.org.uk)
  2. All ponies in Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and conform to the height limits laid down by their Breed Societies.
  3. **No Stallions or colts two years old or over.**
  4. All riders must have attained their 3<sup>rd</sup> birthday before the 1<sup>st</sup> January in the current year.
  5. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years or under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
  6. In all classes whips / canes must not exceed 75 cm. (30").
  7. The decision of the Judge is final. Any objection must be handed in to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit.
  8. The Committee reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or sub-divide any class as may seem justified.
  9. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without giving a reason.
  10. Every effort has been made when drawing up the schedule of events to avoid classes coinciding, but in the event of having ponies entered in classes which do take place at the same time, the exhibitor must choose which class to enter and **NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE. No entry into the ring once the rope is across the entrance.**
  11. All vehicles parked at owner's risk.
  12. No entry fees will be refunded unless a veterinary certificate is presented.
  13. Neither the Committee nor the Landowner will be held responsible for any accident or damage to persons, animals or property on the showground.
  14. Correctly secured current British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
  15. No ponies to be left unattended when tied to the outside of the horsebox/trailer
  16. All dogs must be kept on leads and all dog toilet picked up and removed.
  17. We strongly recommend that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance.
  18. In the event of cancellation a proportion of entry fees may be withheld.

INHAND – Judge Miss D Hayward

- Class 1 - Novice Youngstock - pony not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> prize
- Class 2 – Novice 4 years or over - pony not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> or 2<sup>nd</sup> prize
- Class 3 – Riding Pony (must be plaited)
- Class 4 – Hunter Pony (must be plaited)
- Class 5 – Coloured (broken coloured/dun/palomino/roan), ponies not exceeding 15hh

**NOT BEFORE 11 am –**  
RIDDEN – Judge - Mrs J Cooper

- Class 6 – Novice Nursery (no cantering), ponies not exceeding 15hh
- Class 7 – Pony not to have appeared in the ring, under saddle, before the day of the show. Ponies not exceeding 15hh
- Class 8 – Any Novice Ridden pony up to 13.2hh or M&M Small breeds – pony not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize under saddle (snaffle bridle)
- Class 9 – Any Novice Ridden exc 13.2hh not exceeding 15hh or M&M large breeds - pony not to have won a 1<sup>st</sup> prize under saddle (snaffle bridle)
- Class 10 - Mountain and Moorland Leading Rein ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 10 years or under on the day of the show
- Class 11 – Mountain and Moorland small breeds
- Class 12 – Mountain and Moorland large breeds

**RING TWO – 9.00AM START**  
INHAND – Judge Mr B Orchard

- Class 13 - Young Handler aged 5 to 9 years old
- Class 14 – Young Handler aged 10 – 15 years old
- Class 15 – Mountain and moorland small breeds
- Class 16 – Mountain and moorland large breeds
- Class 17 – Best Condition Grass Kept, ponies not exceeding 15hh
- Class 18 – Veteran – Ponies aged 15 or over

- Class 19 –Leading Rein, ponies not exceeding 12.2hh. Riders 10 years or under on the day of the show
