

## RULES FOR THE 2012 INDOOR SHOW

1. This show will be run accordance with the Pony Club rules for Show Jumping 2012. Pony Club rules for Show Jumping 2012 are available to download from the Pony Club website [www.pcuk.org](http://www.pcuk.org) and a copy will be held with the secretary on the day of the competition. **This includes wearing the correct Pony Club attire.**
2. Approved hard hats must be worn by all riders at all times when mounted. All Pony Club members must wear a hat tagged with the purple Pony Club hat tags.
3. No ponies less than four years old and no stallions.
4. No pony to compete more than once in any class and in no more than 3 classes in total.
5. No refund of entry fee without vet's or doctor's certificate. No refunds or transfers after closing date.
6. The organisers reserve the right to alter the classes if necessary and to refuse any entry.
7. Any objections are to be made to the secretary within 30 minutes of the end of the class, together with £20, refundable at the discretion of the committee.
8. Neither the organisers nor any person acting on their behalf accept liability for any loss, damage, accident, injury or illness to ponies, horses, competitors, spectators or any other persons or property.
9. No mucking out of horseboxes or trailers onto the car park. Please clear up any loose hay and droppings before leaving. No horses to be left tied outside trailers/lorries unattended.
10. The judge's decision is final. In the event of cancellation, entry fees will be refunded less £2.50 per rider to cover administration costs.

Leave A34 N. of Winchester at Three Maids Hill Roundabout (A27/B3420), left onto Andover Rd. North towards Winchester, first right onto Harestock Road, right at end onto Stockbridge/Winchester Rd.(B3049), left at Sparsholt College sign (4 miles from A34)

### Two Phase Show Jumping Rules (Class 6 & 7)

Competitors jump only one round. Those who jump clear over the first part of the course (not against the clock), remain in the ring and carry on round the rest of the course which will be against the clock (timing will start automatically). If the bell rings after the first part of the course, you have not gone clear and must leave the arena.

## INDOOR ARENA - Starting at 9 a.m prompt.

- CLASS 1** 1ft JUMPING 10 yrs & under  
(Rosettes for all double clears). Jumps not to exceed 1ft  
On the lead rein. To be judged on style.
- CLASS 2** 1ft JUMPING 10 yrs & under  
(Rosettes for all double clears). Jumps not to exceed 1ft  
**Off the lead rein** – riders may have 1 adult in school as support/  
encouragement during 1<sup>st</sup> round (no leading). Jump off judged on a  
bogey time – this **IS NOT** a speed class.
- CLASS 3** 1ft 6in JUMPING 12 yrs & under  
(Rosettes for all double clears). Jumps not to exceed 1ft 6 in  
On the lead rein. To be judged on style.
- CLASS 4** 1 ft 6in JUMPING 12 yrs & under  
(Rosettes for all double clears). Jumps not to exceed 1ft 6in  
**Off the lead rein** – riders may have 1 adult in school as support/  
encouragement during 1<sup>st</sup> round (no leading). Jump off judged on a  
bogey time – this **IS NOT** a speed class.
- CLASS 5** 2ft OPEN JUMPING  
**Jumps not to exceed 2ft.** Riders may have 1 adult in school as  
support/encouragement during 1<sup>st</sup> round (**no leading**). Jump off  
judged on a bogey time - this **IS NOT** a speed class.
- CLASS 6** 2ft 3in JUMPING - 2 Phase  
(Competitors entering this class must not enter classes 1, 2, 3 & 4)  
**Jumps not to exceed 2'3"**  
Jump off judged on a bogey time - this **IS NOT** a speed class.
- CLASS 7** 2ft 6in JUMPING – 2 Phase  
(Competitors entering this class must not enter classes 1, 2, 3, 4 or 5)  
**Jumps not to exceed 2'6"**  
Jump off judged on a bogey time - this **IS NOT** a speed class.

Entry Fees £9.00 per class for PC members only and £10.00 (other competitors)

Rosettes to tenth place in each class
