

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

1. It shall be deemed a condition of entry that the organisers, the landowner and his agents shall not be held responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies howsoever caused on the premises.
2. These competitions will be run in accordance with the Riding Club Rulebook 2012. All tests are available from British Dressage on 02476 698830 or from their website www.britishdressage.co.uk.
3. Riders must wear hard hats to British Standard EN 1384, ASTM F1163 or PAS015, or any higher standard in force on the show date, properly fastened at all times when mounted. Helmets must have plain, dark coloured covers.
4. The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the said offence to the show organisers accompanied by a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
5. The Organiser reserves the right to cancel or alter classes and refuse any entries without explanation. In the event of cancellation, refunds will be made less £3 per entry form to cover administration costs.
6. No entry fee will be refunded without a doctors or vets certificate and a stamped self-addressed envelope sent to the entries secretary within 14 days of the date of the competition.
7. Absolutely no telephone entries.
8. All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
9. No horse or pony may be ridden by more than one rider in any class.
10. No lungeing permitted.
11. Dogs should be kept on a lead at all times and kept to the lorry park.
12. Please use the bins provided for litter
13. Please remove droppings etc from lorry/trailer area when you leave.
14. In the interests of health and safety, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and obey the instructions of the Organiser and the Stewards.

Preliminary Restricted Section:

Horse and Rider combinations who have been placed 1st or 2nd in a dressage competition do not qualify to ride in the Restricted section.

Horse and Rider combinations who have competed at Elementary Level or BE Novice Horse Trials do not qualify to ride in the Restricted section.

Non-members £12 per class**
