- Class 3 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding
- Class 4 Dales, Fell & Highland. 1, 2 or 3 year old. Colt, filly or gelding

- Class 13 Registered Part – Bred M & M. 4 years old or over. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

RING TWO – 9 AM START - In Hand

- Class 14 Hunter Pony. Yearling not to exc 153cm at maturity. Colt, filly or gelding.
- Class 15 Hunter Pony. 2 or 3 year old not to exc 153cm at maturity. Colt, filly or gelding .
- Class 16 Hunter Pony. 4 years old or over not exc 153cm. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 14 - 16 to come forward

- Class 19 Riding Pony. 4 years old or over not to exc 148cm. Stallion, barren mare or gelding

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 17 - 19 to come forward

NPS / Laybalands Stud Show Pony In Hand Silver Medal Rosette Championship. A Silver Medal Rosette is offered by the National Pony Society for the best registered pony owned by an NPS Full, Standard or Life member in the Show Pony In Hand section.

- Class 22 Any Part Bred Ridden. 4 years or over not exceeding 153cm. Stallion, barren mare or gelding. Rider any age
- Class 23 Ridden Registered Pure, Part or Anglo Arab. 4 years old or over. Stallion, barren mare or gelding. Rider any age.
- Class 24 Ridden Coloured Pony. 4 years old or over. Stallion, mare or gelding. not exceeding 153cm. Open to any type. Rider any age.

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 22 – 24 to come forward

- Class 25 Hunter Pony not exceeding 153cm, mare or gelding. Rider any age
- Class 26 Riding Pony not exceeding 148cm mare or gelding. Rider any age

RING THREE – 9 AM START

Class 27 Novice mare or gelding under 153cm never to have appeared in the ring under saddle before the day of the show.

Class 28 Novice stallion under 153cm not to have won a 1st prize under saddle at an affiliated show.

Class 29 Novice mare or gelding under 153cm not to have won a 1st prize under saddle at an affiliated show.

Class 30 Leading Rein not exceeding 122cm mare or gelding. Rider 10 years old or under on the day of the show. Please note rule 5.

Class 31 First Ridden not exceeding 128cm mare or gelding. Rider 12 years old or under on the day of the show. Please note rule 5.

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 27 – 31 to come forward

NPS Winter Championship Qualifying Rounds

This show is affiliated to the National Pony Society and the NPS affiliated classes will be run under NPS rules. Classes are open to Members and Non-Members of the NPS, but Non-Members will need to become Full members to enter the finals at the NPS Spring Festival 2012. The NPS General Rules for Showing apply (see NPS website for details).

In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2011/2012 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2012 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions.

Class 32 NPS / T.C. TACK & THINGS M&M LEADING REIN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

Open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 122cms. To be shown in a snaffle bit and led by an attendant. The leading rein to be attached to the noseband only, the reins must go directly from the bit to the rider's hands. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 9th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

Class 33 NPS / KBIS M&M FIRST RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to mares and geldings four years old or over, registered in the main body of their respective Mountain and Moorland Stud Book. Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland, New Forest and Welsh Section A & B. Not exceeding 128cms. Riders must have attained their 3rd but not have attained their 12th birthday (riders' ages are as at 1st January in the current year).

NPS / FIRLE STUD M&M NOVICE RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Pony not to have won a first prize of £10 or more in any open Ridden M&M Class. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules)

Class 34 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

Class 35 Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

NPS / SNUGGY HOODS M&M OPEN RIDDEN WINTER CHAMPIONSHIP

This Competition is open to stallions, mares and geldings four years old or over which must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Book. Rider any age (except stallions – see NPS Rules).

Class 36 Dartmoor, Exmoor, Shetland and Welsh Section A & B.

Class 37 Connemara, Dales, Fells, Highlands, New Forest and Welsh Section C & D.

Championship - 1st & 2nd prizewinners from classes 32 – 37 to come forward

RING FOUR – UNAFFILIATED - 9 am Start – Ridden

NO PONY HEIGHT OR RIDER AGE RESTRICTIONS IN THE FOLLOWING CLASSES UNLESS SPECIFIED

- Class 41 Walk & Trot

Not before Noon - In-Hand

- Class 46 Lorry Dog. Specials will be awarded to various categories, at the judges discretion, within the class
- Class 47 Young Handler aged 11 or under
- Class 48 Young Handler aged 12 -16
- Class 50 Best Conditioned - stabled/part stabled
- Class 51 Best Conditioned – grass kept
- Class 52 Veteran 15 +, will be split if sufficient entries

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. To be judged under NPS rules. These may be obtained from The National Pony Society Tel 01420 88333 or www.nationalponysociety.org.uk
2. All ponies in Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and conform to the height limits laid down by their Breed Societies. There is no height limit for Welsh Cobs, Section D.
3. All stallions and colts, 2 years old or over, must be in possession of a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society.
4. Stallions and colts, two years old or over must be adequately bitted.
5. All riders must have attained their 3rd birthday before the 1st January in the current year
6. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 14 years or under must wear correctly secured British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
7. In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 11 years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
8. In Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony classes riders must be 11 years old or over when riding stallions not exceeding 128 cm and 14 years old or over when riding stallions exceeding 128 cms.
9. In all classes whips / canes must not exceed 75 cm. (30").
10. The decision of the Judge is final. Any objection must be handed in to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident, accompanied by a £10 deposit.
11. The Committee reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or sub-divide any class as may seem justified.
12. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without giving a reason.
13. Every effort has been made when drawing up the schedule of events to avoid classes coinciding, but in the event of having ponies entered in classes which do take place at the same time, the exhibitor must choose which class to enter and **NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE. No entry into the ring once the rope is across the entrance.**
14. All vehicles parked at owner's risk.
15. Ponies are not to be left unattended whilst tied to the outside of vehicles/trailers.
16. No entry fees will be refunded unless a veterinary certificate is presented.
17. Neither the Committee nor the Landowner will be held responsible for any accident or damage to persons, animals or property on the showground.
18. Correctly secured current British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
19. All dogs must be kept on leads and all dog toilet picked up and removed.
20. We strongly recommend that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance.
21. In the event of cancellation a proportion of entry fees may be withheld.

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships:

NPS Silver Medal Rosette Championships: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. NPS Silver Medal Rosettes are only awarded when the owner of the champion pony is a Full, Standard or Life member of the NPS. A valid membership card must be in the rider's/handler's possession on entering the ring and be produced immediately on request by either the judge or the steward. If the owner of the Champion pony is not a member, or the owner's membership card is not immediately produced, the rosette may be awarded to the Reserve Champion provided they have the required membership card. If the Champion pony has previously qualified it is still entitled to the Silver Medal Rosette but the qualification card goes to the Reserve Champion pony, provided the owner of that pony is a member of the NPS. The Silver Medal Rosette and the qualification card can be awarded no lower than first Reserve (third). Foals are not eligible for Silver Medal Championships.

ROYAL LONDON SHOW QUALIFICATION

First, second and third placed horses/ponies in the following classes; 1 – 21, 23- 26, 30 – 37, 44, 47 -48 & 52 will qualify for the Champion of Britain Title classes to be held at the Royal London Show in 2012. Each qualified horse/pony will receive a qualification card in the ring which will enable the owner to enter the Royal London Show, provided the owner and rider/handler are, or become registered with the International Showing Society within 28 days of the qualifying show.
