

RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

**Admission is granted and entries accepted only on these terms.
Anyone not complying with these rules may be asked to leave.**

- The organisers, the landowner and his agents shall not be responsible for any loss, injury or damage to competitors, onlookers, their property, servants or horses or ponies howsoever caused on the premises. **A condition of entry is that all competitors have a minimum of third party public liability insurance.**
- These competitions will be run under British Dressage rules. All tests are available from British Dressage on ☎ 02476 698830 or www.britishdressage.co.uk.
- When mounted riders must wear hard hats, properly fastened at all times, to British Standard EN1384, ASTM F1163 or PAS015, or any higher standard in force on the show date. Helmets must have plain, dark coloured covers.
- It is College Farm Policy that NO DOGS are allowed on the premises.**
- Classes are limited, with a wait list kept and riders informed when phoning for start times.
- The judge's decision in all cases is final.** Any objection must be made in writing within 20 minutes of the said offence to the show organisers accompanied by a £20 deposit. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
- The Organiser reserves the right to cancel any show, alter classes and refuse any entries without explanation. In the event of cancellation refunds will be made, less £3 per entry form to cover administration costs.
- No entry fee will be refunded without a doctor's or vet's certificate and a stamped, self-addressed envelope sent to the Entries Secretary.
- All horses and ponies must be 4 years old or over.
- Please contact the Organiser if you would like to bring / compete a stallion.
- Horses and ponies must not be tied up outside horseboxes or trailers and left unattended.
- No lungeing or galloping permitted.
- Please use the bins provided for litter and droppings.
- In the interests of health and safety everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents and obey the instructions of the Organiser and the Stewards.

- Classes 1 and 2 **only**: Open Section (O), Restricted Section (R), see above
- Members must have joined WRC 2 weeks before the competition date.

CLEAR ROUND DRESSAGE ARENA

- whether you are a junior rider (under 18 on 1 January 2012).

Please enter in good time to avoid disappointment.

ENTRIES CLOSE on the Sunday before the competition.

WITHDRAWALS as soon as possible to the Secretary.

WARMING UP and **TESTS** are on artificial surfaces.

PRIZES

- ▶ **Rosettes** to sixth place in all classes
- ▶ **Special rosette** to highest placed junior in all classes
- ▶ **WRC MEMBERS ONLY:** Within the top six places in each class:
£10 to first, £5 to second, £5 to third placed riders
- ▶ **WRC MEMBERS** must have joined 2 weeks before the competition date.
