Rules and Condition of Entry

- 1. To be judged under NPS rules 2025. These may be obtained from The National Pony Society Tel 01420 88333 or www.nationalponysociety.com
- 2. All ponies in Mountain & Moorland classes must be registered in their respective Stud Books and conform to the height limits laid down by their Breed Societies. There is no height limit for Welsh Cobs, Section D or Dales
- 3. All stallions and colts, 2 years old or over, must be in possession of a current Stallion Licence, unless otherwise governed by their individual Breed Society. They must also be adequately bitted.
- 4. In classes run under NPS Rules the age of riders and handlers are all taken as at 1st January of the current year. The only exception is for Leading Rein classes where the child must be at least 3 years old on the day of the class.
- 5. No child under the age of 7 may compete in any in-hand classes (except fancy dress and young handler classes)
- 6. Handlers of ponies in In Hand classes aged 7-14 years must wear correctly secured British Standard skull caps / riding hats.
- In Mountain and Moorland classes riders of stallions must be 12years old or over when riding small breeds (Shetland, Dartmoor, Exmoor, Welsh A & B). For large breeds (Highland, Fell, Dales, Connemara, New Forest, Welsh C & D) riders of stallions must be 14 years old or over.
- 8. Whiskers are not to be trimmed for any breed. This rule is now mandatory.
- 9. In Show Pony/Show Hunter Pony classes riders must be 12 years old or over when riding stallions not exceeding 128 cm and 14 years old or over when riding stallions exceeding 128cms.
- 10. In all classes whips / canes must not exceed 75 cm. (30") and if they are misused, in the opinion of the judge, the rider may be sent out of the ring and may also be reported to the NPS.
- 11. The decision of the Judge is final provided all relevant rules have been followed. Any objection must be handed in to the Secretary in writing within 10 minutes of the alleged incident, accompanied by a £30 deposit.
- 12. The Committee reserve the right to cancel, amalgamate or sub-divide any class as may seem justified.
- 13. The Committee reserve the right to refuse entry to any person without giving a reason.
- 14. Every effort has been made when drawing up the schedule of events to avoid classes coinciding, but in the event of having ponies entered in classes which do take place at the same time, the exhibitor must choose which class to enter, and NO REFUND OF ENTRIES WILL BE MADE.
- 15. The class is closed, and ponies will not be allowed into the ring: -In-Hand – When the last pony has done its individual trot around the ring before being lined up Ridden – When the class goes into trot Leading Rein – When the last pony has done its individual trot
- 16. All vehicles parked at owner's risk.
- 17. Ponies are not to be left unattended whilst tied to the outside of vehicles / trailers
- 18. All Riders, whether they are in the show ring or warming up area, should be of a suitable size for the pony that they are riding.
- 19. Any person on the showground found to be ill-treating animals at any time whether misuse/excessive use of whip, bit, spurs or any item of saddlery or any other way whatsoever will be asked to leave the show ground and may be reported to the NPS Disciplinary Committee.
- 20. No entry fees will be refunded unless a veterinary certificate is presented.
- 21. Neither the Committee nor the Landowner will be held responsible for any accident or damage to persons, animals or property on the showground and we strongly recommend that all exhibitors carry Public Liability Insurance.
- 22. Correctly secured current British Standard Skull Caps / Riding Hats must be worn at all times when mounted on the showground.
- 23. All dogs must be kept on leads and all dog toilet picked up and removed.
- 24. In the event of cancellation, a proportion of entry fees will be withheld. <u>NPS Qualifying Rounds</u>: These classes are judged under the Rules of the NPS. Ponies must be registered in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part breds are not eligible for Mountain & Moorland Classes. To compete in Show Pony and Show Hunter Pony classes ponies must be registered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB, the GSB, the AHSB, the AASB or in the main body of their respective Mountain & Moorland Stud Books. Part-Breds are not eligible unless entered in the NPS British Riding Pony Stud Book, Register, Appendix, International or Sports Pony section of the BRPSB. Qualifying rounds for most NPS Summer competitions are open to ponies owned by NPS members and non-members but only ponies owned by adult NPS Qualifying or Life members are eligible to qualify for the final of the competition at the NPS Summer Championship Show at Malvern from 5th 7th August 2025. NPS Winter Qualifiers are open to members and non-members, the owner must become a Qualifying or Life member of the NPS to enter the final. For Winter qualifiers In each class the three highest placed ponies, not already qualified, within the first six places, will qualify. Winnings in the 2024/2025 Novice and Pure Novice Winter Championships will not debar ponies from the NPS 2025 Mountain and Moorland Novice Ridden competitions. Qualification cards will be awarded in the ring.
- 25. NPS/WTJ Insurance Brokers Ltd Home-Produced Ridden Championship. Riders of Home-Produced ponies (see definition in the NPS Rules Book) can wear a white arm band in classes where this is indicated. These ponies, if owned by NPS

members, are then eligible to qualify for the final at the NPS Summer Championship Show. The Owner's Membership cards **MUST** be produced in the ring when requested or the qualification will be forfeit.
