Championships and National Pony Society Finals***

All classes to be run under the PC Arena Eventing Guidelines 2026

Competitors will jump a course of show jumps immediately followed by a course of knock down cross-country style fences. The XC section will have an optimum time based on a speed of 325 mpm (80 and below), and 375 mpm (PC90 and above) penalties will be given for every commenced second in excess of the optimum time at 0.4 penalty and every commenced second in excess of 5 seconds under the optimum time at 0.4 penalty.

Class 2 – 60cm – Incorporating a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour, NPS/ANTHONY EVANS ARENA EVENTING CHALLENGE FINAL 2026

HHNPC RULES AND CONDITIONS OF ENTRY

All classes will be a series of Show Jumps followed by a series of knock down Arena Eventing fences. The Arena Eventing section will be timed with an Optimum Time.

Entries are accepted and admission granted only subject to the following conditions, which are deemed to have been accepted by each competitor:

1. The competition will be run in accordance with the Pony Club Eventing Rules 2026.
2. Each combination may enter a **maximum of 2 classes**, and the 30cm rule will be observed. For example if a combination jumps 60cm, they may not jump 90cm.
3. Horses or ponies **must be 5 years or over** on the day of the show and no stallions without written permission from the DC.
4. All hats must be **jockey skull caps with no fixed peak** and must comply with current Pony Club Rule book.
5. **Body protectors are compulsory** and must comply with current Pony Club regulations. As a minimum shoulders must be covered while competing.
6. PC members wearing Spurs must have passed either there C+ Ride, or Spurs Test and have a hat tag.
7. No jewellery (including watches) allowed. **No stopwatches** to be worn by riders whilst competing.
8. Competitors should familiarise themselves with changes to the whip rule for 2023 onwards which will be strictly enforced, along with the Pony Club dress code.
9. The judge's decision is final. Any objection must be made in writing to the Secretary with a deposit of £20 no later than 20 minutes after the end of the class. The deposit will only be returned if the objection is upheld.
10. There will be an unmounted prize giving after each class. Prize winning competitors are expected to be properly dressed as for competition for the prize giving.
11. Refunds (less an administration charge of £5) will only be given on withdrawal prior to the closing date. Withdrawals after the closing date will not be refunded for any reason.
12. In the event of the competition being abandoned a refund of 50% will be given.
13. Late entries will be accepted only at the discretion of the organisers and will be subject to a £5 late entry fee.
14. The organisers of this event have taken all reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present at this event. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents. They must obey the instructions of the organiser and all officials and stewards. It is a condition of entry that each competitor shall indemnify the above mentioned against such matter aforesaid.
15. The organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry without stating a reason for doing so and also reserve the right to eliminate any competitor who in their opinion places her/himself or others in danger or fails to observe rules or compromises their horse/ponies welfare.
16. **No dogs in the arena or cafe.** All dogs outside the arena must be kept on a lead.
17. **All droppings, hay and rubbish to be picked up and taken home.**
18. No horse/ponies are to be left unattended when tied to the lorry/trailer.
19. Horses and ponies must be ridden at a walk unless in a competition or warm-up area.
20. There will be a photographer at this event. It is the responsibility of any individual not wishing to be photographed to notify them directly

60, 70, 80 and 90cm classes are a qualifier for the **NPS/ ANTHONY EVANS ARENA EVENTING CHALLENGE FINAL 2026**. The Final venue TBC. The final is open to mares, geldings and stallions four year old and over, not exceeding 158cm, in possession of an equine passport but no specific registration or breed society criteria. Ponies' manes may be plaited at competitor discretion. Qualification will be gained by achieving a top 10 placing or a double clear in a qualifying class. Qualification will be confirmed by the NPS Office. Any qualification gained in the 60/ 70cm or 80/ 90cm will jump the higher limit in the final. Riders may only ride one pony in each class at the final. Only ponies owned by NPS members (Life, Qualifying or Performance) can qualify for the final (must be a member at time of qualification).

SEEL Arena Eventing Championships

This years final is at Lodge farm in Matfield, Kent will host this years SEEL Arena Eventing Championship on 14 June 26. The Finals will be run on grass this year, with 9/10 show jumping fences, followed immediately by the Cross Country section which will finish in the water complex. This popular venue in Kent which boasts incredible ground, even in June also hosts the BRC combined challenge and 'The Lodge Farm Eventers Challenge' which will run alongside. To qualify, combinations must finish in the top ten at the numerous qualifying SEEL Arena Eventing at 80/80 or 100 classes.

 **Qualifier show for
Sunshine Tour 2026**

**This show is a qualifier for The Sunshine Tour
Championships held at The All-England
Showground, Hickstead from Thursday 17th –
Sunday 20th September 2026.**

The Championships are for **registered** unaffiliated and amateur competitors in **Dressage** from Intro to Elementary, **Show Jumping** from Lead Rein to 1.0m; **Showing** for lead rein, in-hand, ridden, working hunter, veterans, plus many more, and **Eventer's Challenge** from 50cm through to 90cm.

Qualifying Criteria

Competitor and horse must be registered with Sunshine Tour. Restrictions apply to both horse's and competitor's previous winnings and amateur status, please check the website for Terms & Conditions.

Eligible Placings: Dressage & Show Jumping: 1st – 3rd place in an unaffiliated class held 1st January to 31st July at a registered centre or club. **Eventers Challenge & Showing:** 1st – 4th place in an unaffiliated class held 1st November to 31st December at any centre or club, from 1st January to 31st July at a registered centre or club.

To convert an eligible placing into a qualification: Results must be submitted to Sunshine Tour for verification **within one month** of qualifying competition (by first week of August for all July competitions).
